Thanks again to the committee who organized it all -- it was a great success.

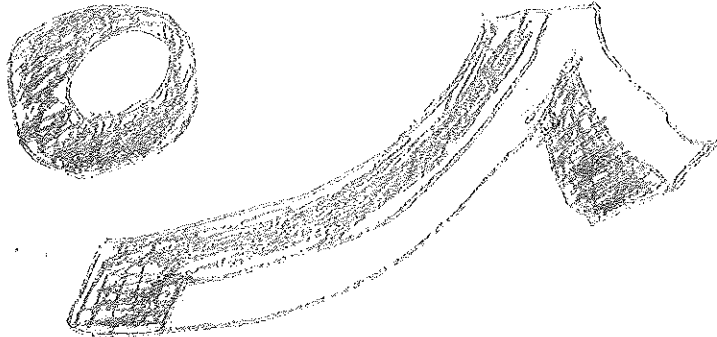

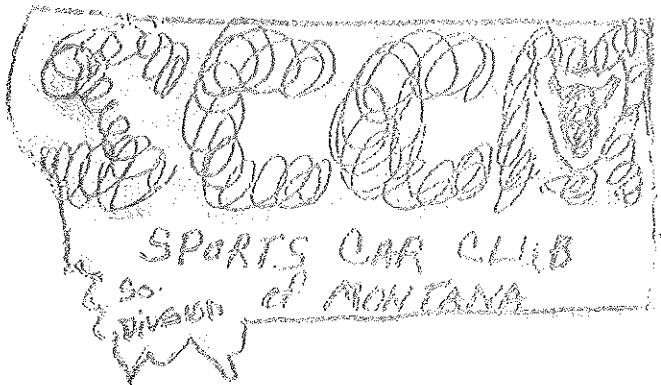
