The first autocross is at Skyview on April 26th. Jim Arnett will chair the event with Alan Walker as the co-chair.

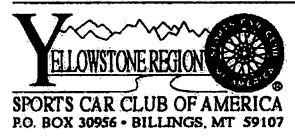
Safety Stewards are in short supply. Those interested should attend the safety steward school planned in the near future by Dale Dinsmore.

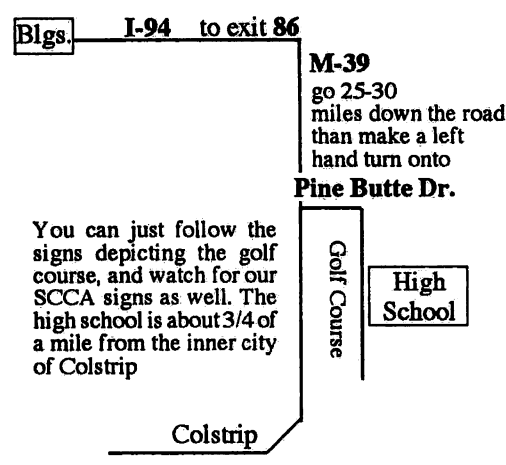
1998 EVENTS

There is quite a program scheduled that means success if done and it can be accomplished with some help from everyone.

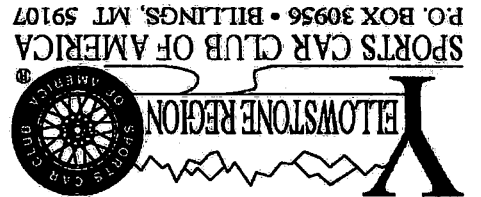
So come to the meetings and help with hand and heart don't just be another member but take an active part.

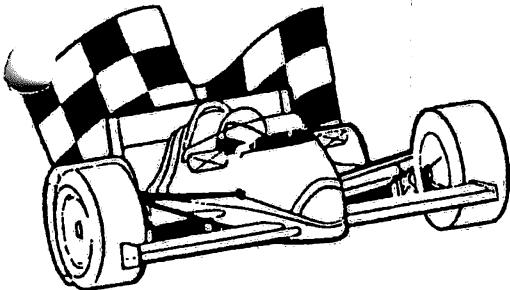
