We all anticipate a good weekend at the Show and Go.

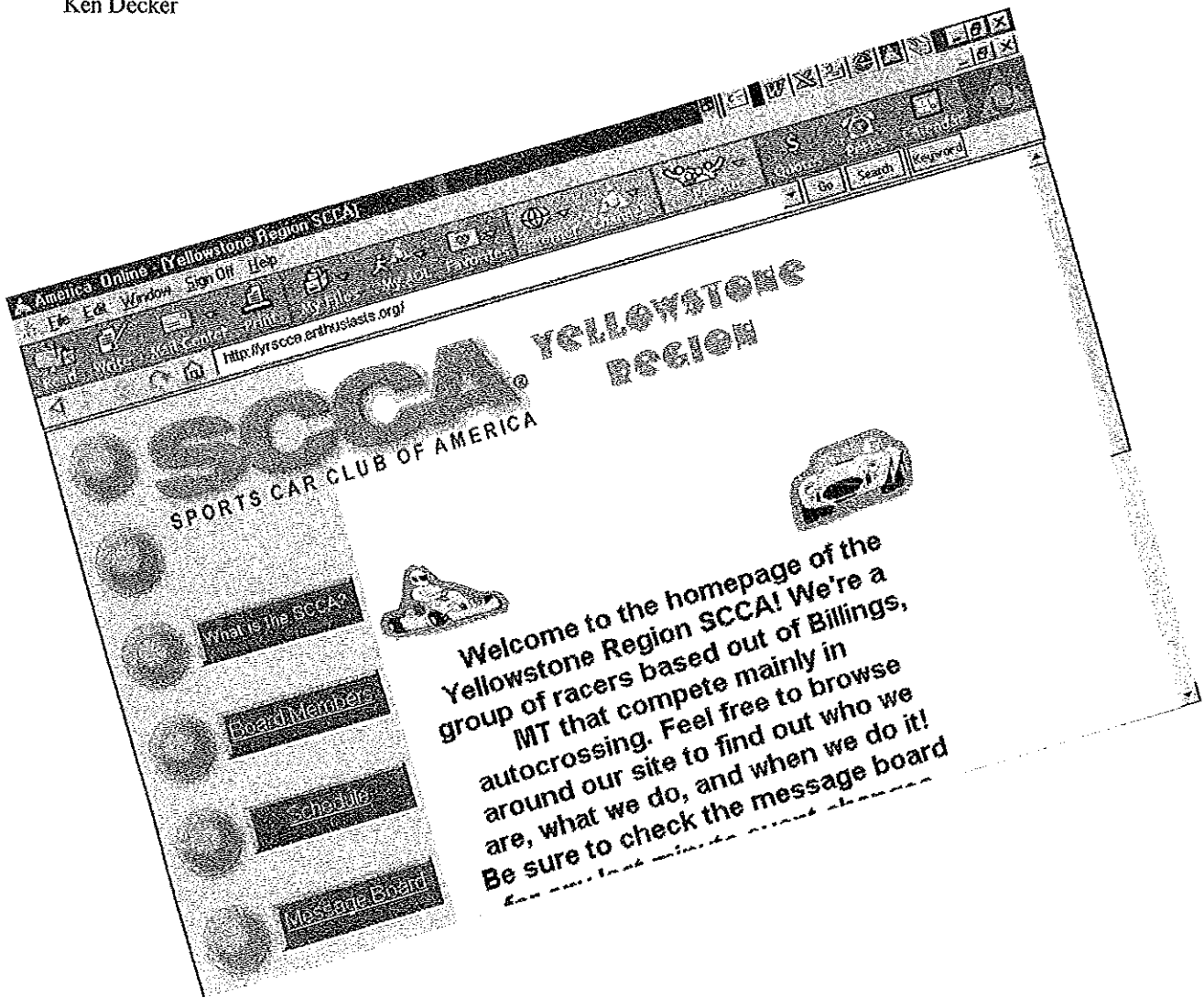
Motion seconded and passed to adjourn meeting.
