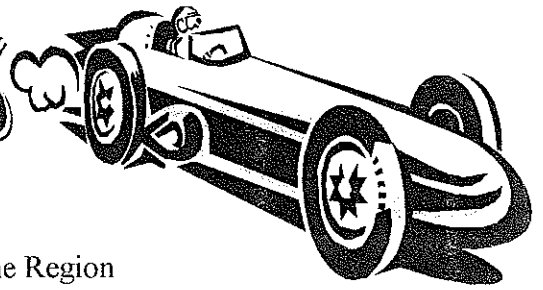

Motion to accept minutes of last meeting as in Fast times seconded & passed.

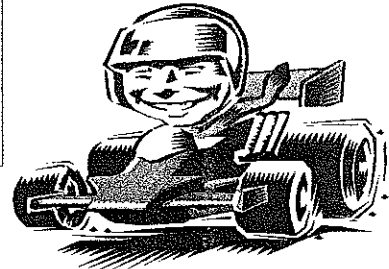
COMMITTEE REPORTS;

Points stay with the car & class and are not transferable to a different class.

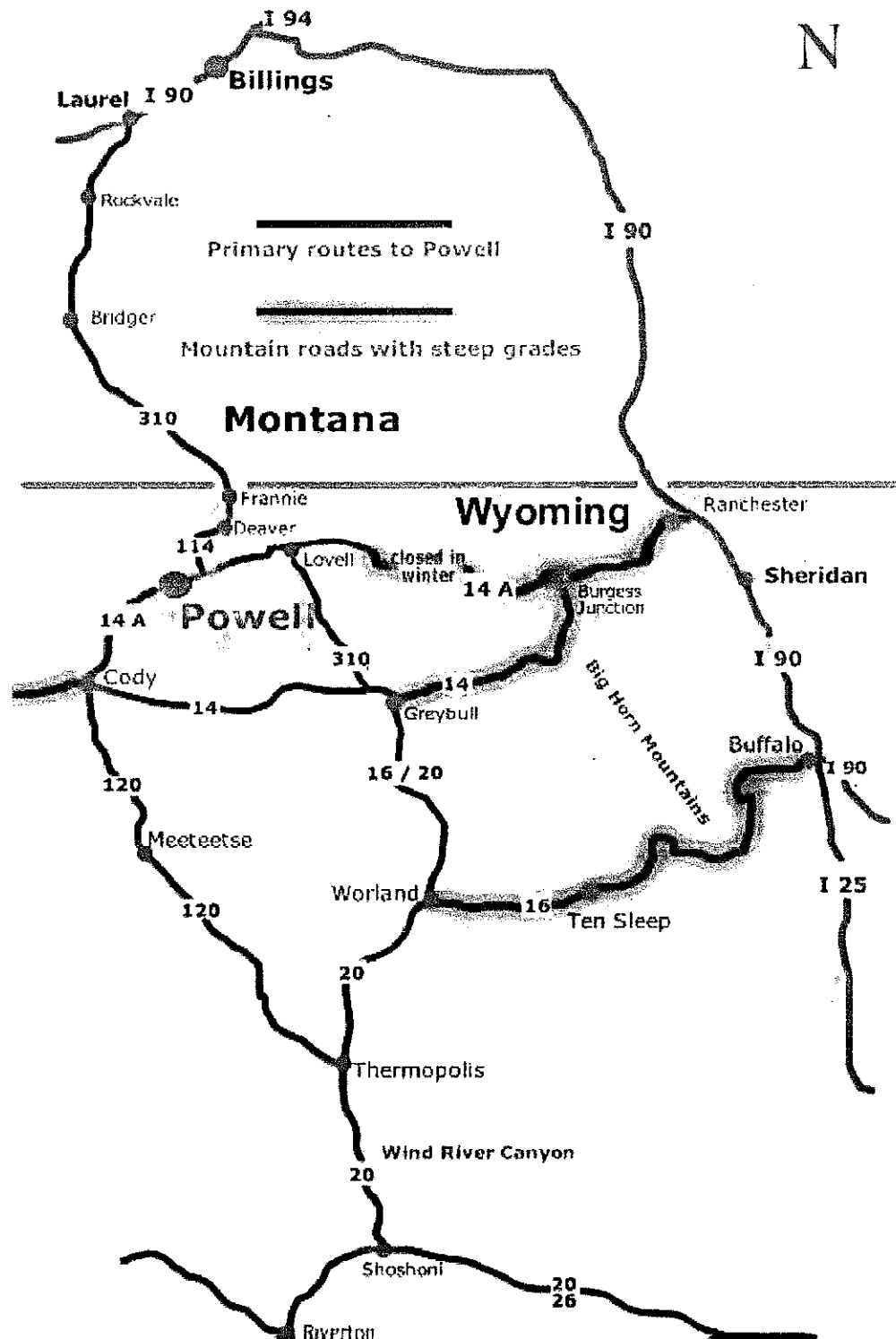

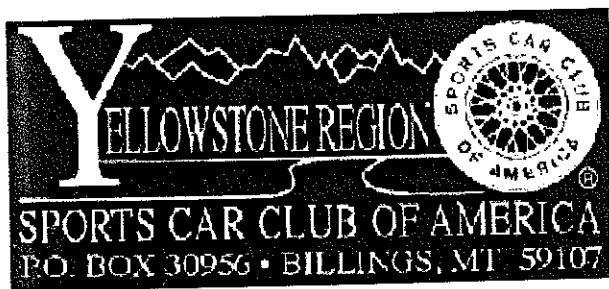
