For those of you who are thinking about attending one of the driver's education events at Lewistown this year, take notice the Porsche club is requiring that tech inspections be conducted prior to arriving at the event. This means that if you arrive at the event without having proof of a technical inspection in hand, you won't be allowed to enter. Accordingly, make sure you have carefully read all the information on the Porsche website if you are considering attending a Lewistown event. There are

links on the Yellowstone Region Event Schedule to the Porsche website and to the tech inspection form. The form does not specify who must perform the tech inspection, but the driver must certify that the inspection was "performed ... by a person able to recognize the components being inspected and assess their condition." The form implies that the tech inspector must be someone other than the driver. The Porsche club has advised us that Dana Motors will do inspections for \$69.00. R.R.
