All cars had finished their runs when the skies opened up shortly after noon.

It was also reported that there were problems with the mast supporting the timing display at the Corvette autocross, but it was later determined that the supporting strap was installed improperly.

New Business: The addition of three new members to the Region was noted. The Region's contact at Food Services of America indicates that the resealing of the lot has been completed and that things are a "go" for the event scheduled there on June 28<sup>th</sup>.

At the top of the PAX results were **Orry Boettger**, **Tucker Stewart**, **Chris Brewer**, and **Luke Bonner**. The quote of the day came from member **Jerod Staebler** after posting his best run of the day: "It sure is different when you're driving your own car!" Jerod's last run revealed real potential in that beautiful black Camaro. (It was later learned that **Ben Caudill's** Intrepid has likely run its last race.)
