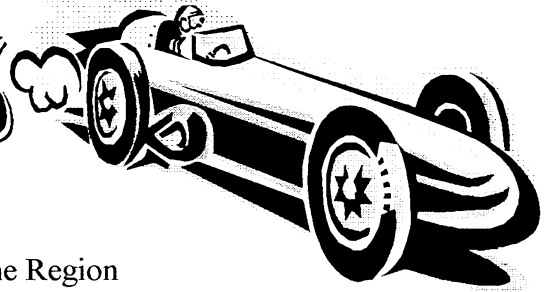

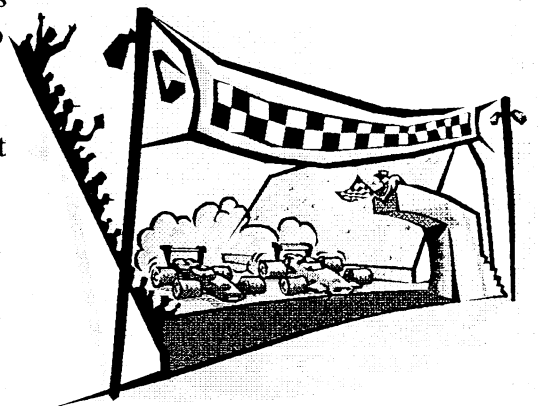

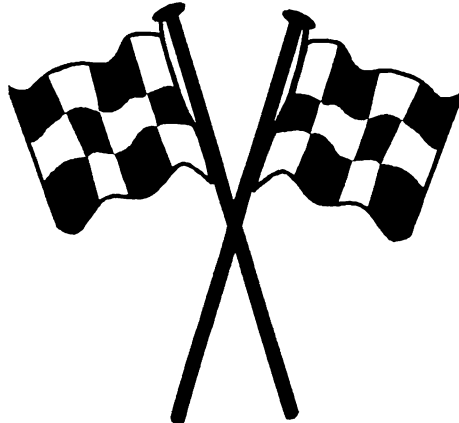
LEWISTOWN
