





Jay Harris of Billings debuted a gorgeous 1999 SVT Cobra—also in red. Although the course was tight, the super-charged Mustang showed its potential.


The last course of the season was laid out by Cooper S pilot


If you have the desire to run for office or to nominate a candidate, please attend the October meeting or e-mail your suggestions to any current officer or the Webmaster:
