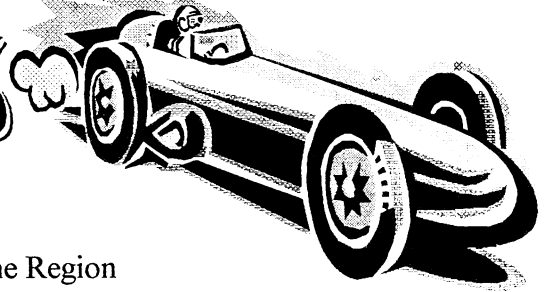

No treasure's report, Mark was out of town.

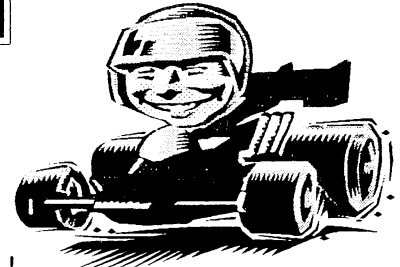
Our old timing equipment will be up for sale on Ebay soon.

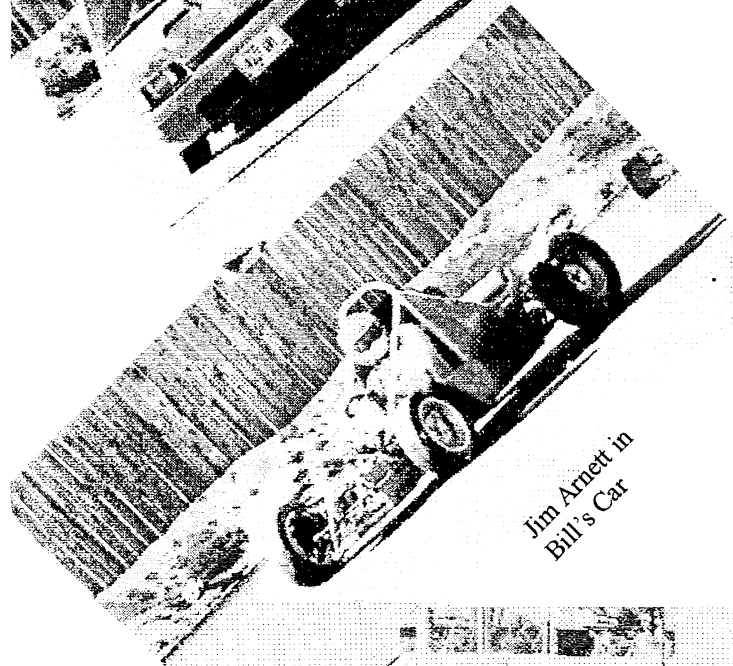

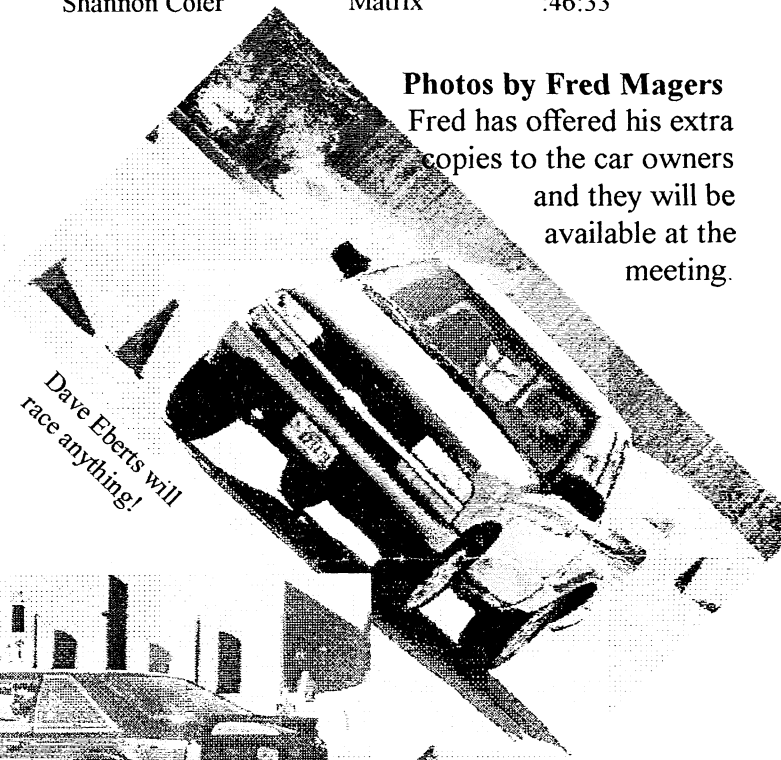

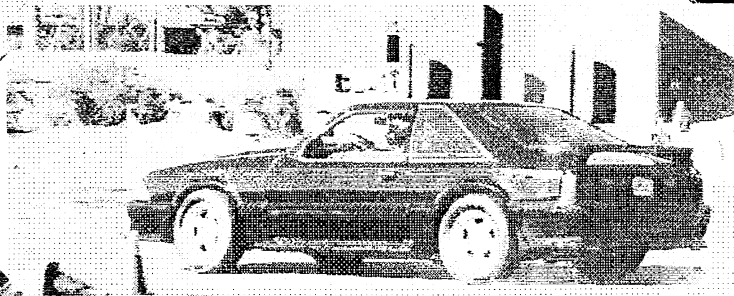

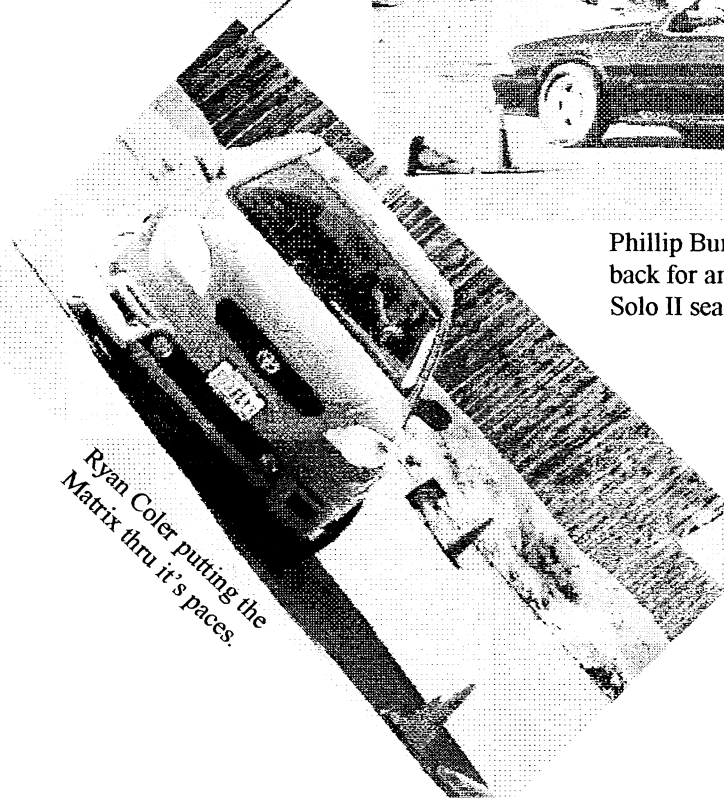

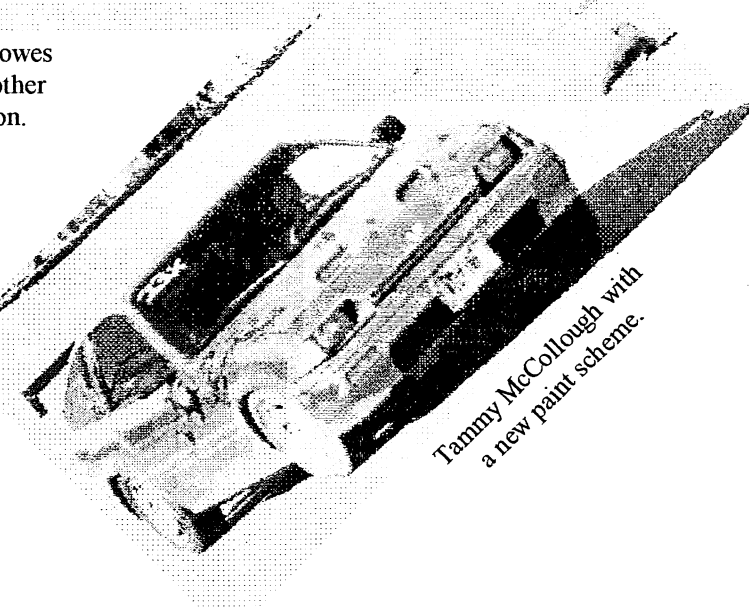

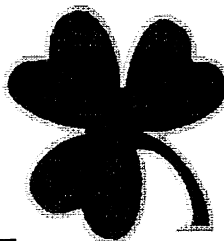
SAFETY SAFETY SAFETY

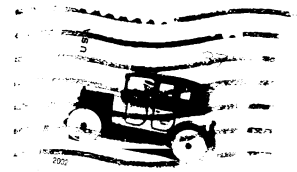
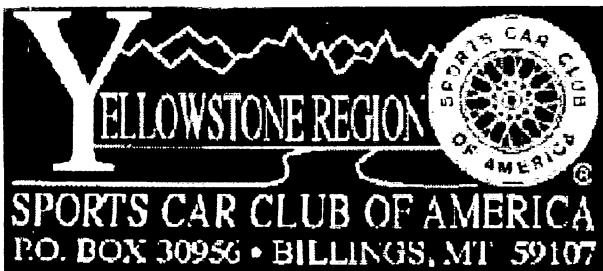
