## MEMBERSHIP

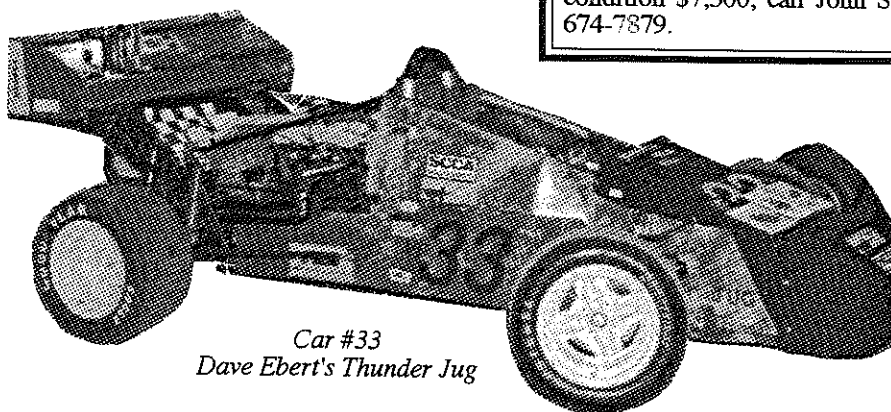

But what can you expect from a crowd whose dominant foot wear is cowboy boots or whose pants are baggy, hat on backwards, mouth breathers? I spent a lot of time there and anyone that showed even the slightest interest got subject to my best sales pitch.

In our display Al & Ron Walker had their Datsun 240Z looks good! Dwight Gilliland had his new full bodied modified, looked fast! Bill Schaff had his little red open wheel modified and with his new body work made it look good and fast! I had Thunder Jug there, looks blue and yellow. I like to remind everyone to check their units

over so you can pass inspection. Minimum helmet requirement this year is a Snell SA or M85 for autocrossing. Seat Belts in sedans and full harness for open cockpit cars. Make sure your battery is secure. Check your engine belts and hoses along with fluid levels, wheel bearings, tie rod ends, steering box and the lug nuts for tightness. Check the fluid levels. Adjust brakes, or make sure you have a decent feeling pedal. It would help if you would get, or find

someone with a Solo 2 rule book and classify your car. I really don't have the time to do it at the first tech inspection so I will just give you a rule book and have you look it up anyway. This will save a lot of time and frustration for everyone if you can determine what class your car falls into beforehand but if you can't figure it out, someone will help you out.

May all your asphalt be firm and warm.
