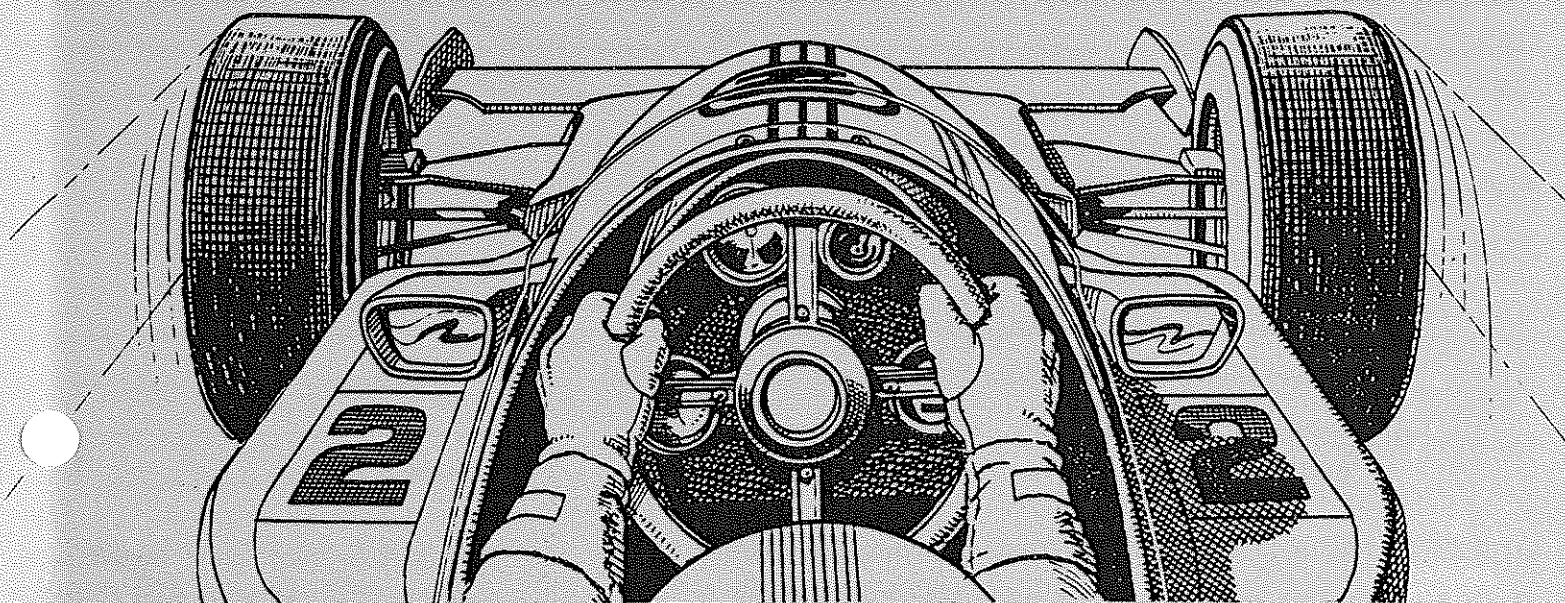

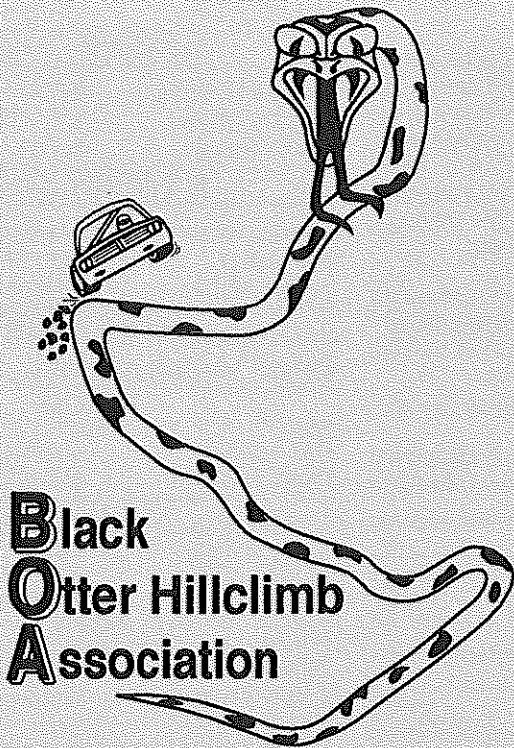

- Roll bars are required in all open cockpit cars.
- 5BC minimum fire extinguishers required in all cars.
- Entry cut off is 60 drivers, maximum three drivers per car.

We will have fire extinguishers available on site for \$25 each with the tech. approved metal retainer, limited number available.
