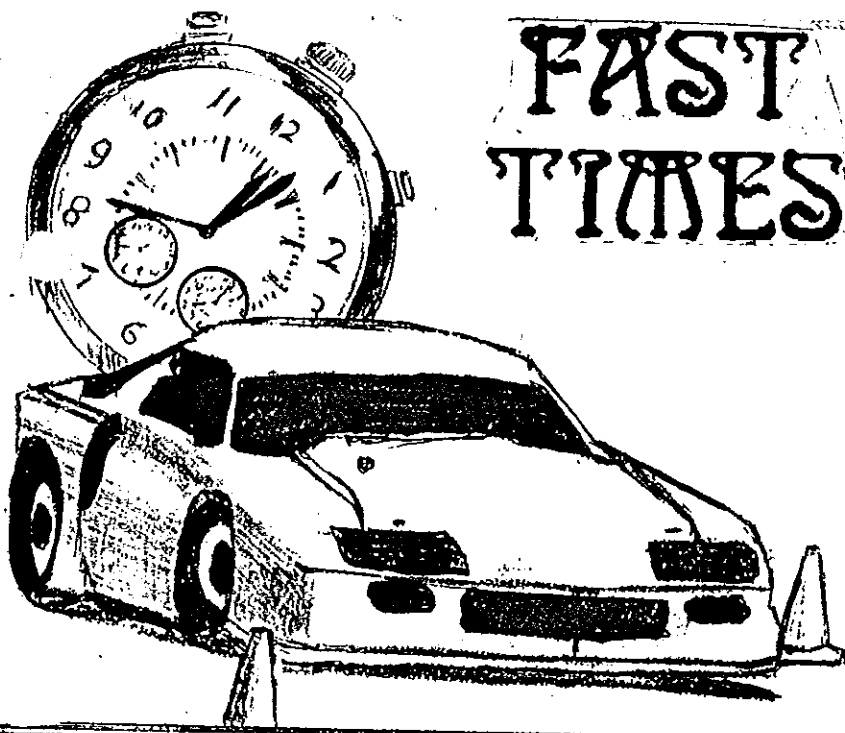

NOVEMBER 7 MEETING MINUTES
